**E**xpectations—Expect the best from your child. Expect your child to use the ABC rule; **A**sk questions and ask for help when they need it, **B**ehave in a manner that allows then and other to learn, **C**omplete class and homework assignments on time.

**V**olunteer- Show your interest and support by volunteering to assist in some capacity.

**E**ncourage- Encourage and recognize your child's efforts.
